About JIS: Jakarta International School is an independent, co-educational institution offering university preparation primarily for expatriate students. JIS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and is a member of the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS) as well as the East Asia Regional Council of Overseas Schools (EARCOS).

Instruction is in English and all students earn a US High School Diploma. Students may elect to enroll in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma during grades 11 and 12 or enroll in individual IB and/or Advanced Placement (AP) courses. The calendar covers 36 weeks over two semesters, August to December and January to June. Students attend four 85-minute class periods per school day.

Students: Of the 888 high school students, about 20% are from the United States, 20% from South Korea, 20% from Indonesia, and the remaining 40% are from more than 45 nations, including India, Canada,

Australia, the Philippines, and the United Kingdom.

Faculty: The faculty includes 99 members from 18 countries; 49 hold Master's degrees, two have doctorates.

Activities: We encourage our students to get involved, try something new, and to make a positive difference in the world. As such we offer a wide variety of activities, including service clubs, sports and fitness clubs, special interest clubs, language clubs, academic clubs and honor societies, as well as 10 varsity sports for both boys and girls.

High School Counseling: The JIS counseling program is a one of a kind program in Indonesia. It provides numerous group sessions, highly individualized course and career planning meetings, after school and before school student workshops, and night seminars, all throughout Freshman, Sophomore, Junior and Senior Years. It is designed to inform our students and families as well as to offer multiple opportunities to better know our students.
