JIS Academy (JA) was established with the aim of offering quality, high-interest academic, fitness, creative and sports activities beyond the normal Jakarta Intercultural School curriculum in order to better serve both students and adults. These activities are run by both expatriate and local instructors and coaches who have specialized knowledge in their field and, therefore, carry a separate fee per program.

During the academic year, the majority of our activities are open to only the JIS community due to limited space. The JIS Academy Summer Program, however, is equally open to JIS Dragons and non-members of the JIS community. Many of the activities featured in our summer



program are inspired by Indonesia's rich cultural heritage, enriching our beautiful campus while also sharing the diversity of our school with all JIS Academy participants. We hope that this also creates an environment that fosters new understandings and new relationships for you and your children.

Fees

The fee of each JIS Academy activity is determined by the cost of the instructors/ coaches, any required materials and uniforms, as well as performances and tournaments, plus a modest JIS facilities fee that helps cover the cost of nurses, ambulances, administrative staff, security and additional after-school supervision, specialized training, technology needs, electricity, and general maintenance.



Payment Options

All activities are priced in Indonesian rupiah. We currently accept VISA, Mastercard and JCB. Here are our recommendations for a smooth experience:

- Online Indonesian credit card this is the fastest and most reliable method you can use.
- 2. Online Foreign 3D secure credit card (like "Verified by Visa" and "Master Card Secure Code") - be sure your bank has up-to-date contact information and/or that you know your password.
- Online Foreign credit card (Non 3D secure credit card), please call your bank in advance and tell them you will be making a charge from Indonesia.
- 4. Offline credit card at the JIS Business Office - payment must be made at the JIS Business Office within seven calendar days of registration, otherwise the system will automatically drop registrants from

- all unpaid activities. Please bring your credit card and pay at the JIS Business Office located in Module H 3rd floor, JIS Cilandak Campus, JI. Terogong Raya No. 33, Jakarta Selatan. Opening hours: Monday Friday, 8:00 am 3:00 pm.
- 5. Bank Transfer payment can be transferred to the account below. Please include the registration number, participant name & the activity in the transfer message to indicate the purpose of the payment, and email JIS Academy with a screenshot of the successful transaction.

Refund Policy

Due to staffing considerations, JIS Academy employs a strict refund policy. There is a IDR 250,000 administrative on refunds unless the class is canceled or changed by JIS Academy.

- 1. Before the second-class meeting: 100 percent refund, minus the IDR 250,000 administrative fee (when applicable).
- After the second-class meeting: No refund.

- 3. JIS Academy reserves the right to cancel all programs due to insufficient enrolment or staffing.
- 4. JIS Academy reserves the right to change or alter dates and times. If a program is canceled by us, there will be 100 percent refund and no administrative fee.
- 5. There will be no refund for a student who is asked to leave the program for inappropriate behavior, the use



of tobacco, drugs or alcohol, nonnotification of a serious medical condition, or whose conduct is detrimental to the program. No refund will be made for a student's late arrival, early vacation or family vacation. All refund decisions are at the sole discretion of JIS Academy.

6. There will be no refund in case of force majeure, natural disaster, unscheduled

school closures for student safety and/ or unscheduled public holidays.

Form of Refund

- Your refund will be processed in fourteen working days.
- Your refund will be issued either in a rupiah check or rupiah cash. The maximum amount that can be refunded in cash is IDR 5 million.

Terms of Service

All families registering for JIS Academy activities must agree to the following policy on the online registration form.

I understand that Jakarta Intercultural School (JIS) rules and regulations will be in effect and that safety precautions will be taken. I also understand that JIS as a foundation, organs of the foundation, and any individual employed by JIS and JIS Academy cannot be held responsible for incidents, accidents, or injuries that occur on campus before, during, or after a JIS Academy activity.

In the event of an injury or accident involving my child, I understand that I will be informed as soon as possible. If I am unable to be contacted, I authorize the representatives of JIS and JIS Academy to act on my behalf in a medical emergency involving my child and I will bear all and any related costs, except for the costs that the school will explicitly cover.



I agree to pay all costs, charges and expenses incurred in relation to providing this medical care along with other associated costs. I hereby release JIS and JIS Academy representatives from the responsibility of bearing any costs and expenses, and I also agree to assume any liability arising from their decision on my behalf. In this regard, I will not bring any suit, assert any claim, or initiate criminal proceedings against JIS and JIS Academy representatives as a result of any action taken to attend to my child or as a result



of the incident involving my child.

I understand and accept that I and/or my child must abide by the JIS Access Code of Conduct and expectations set forth by the instructors, and that I and/or my child can be asked to leave anytime if I and/or my child's conduct is detrimental to the program, as deemed by JIS and JIS representatives, or JIS Academy and JIS Academy representatives.

I understand and accept the JIS Academy Refund Policy and JIS Child Safeguarding Policy.

I understand and agree that in light of the JIS Sharing and Privacy Policy that photos or videos of my children may be taken during activities and possibly used in future publications.

I understand that all programs, courses, descriptions, rates, and dates are subject to change and that all courses and programs are subject to sufficient enrollment.

I understand that JIS Academy reserves the right to decide the composition of student groups in every activity based on student attendance.

I have read and agreed to these conditions as outlined in this document. The information I have given in this registration form is true and correct.

Bus Service

A late bus service is available for regular bus riders. As soon as after-school activities finish, KG – Grades 12 students can ride an after-school activity bus home, which is the last bus service. Please see the bus schedule below.

PIE Dismissal, Pickup and Supervision Procedures

PIE KG - GRADE 5 ACTIVITIES STARTING AT 2:10 PM

At 2:00 PM, children will be escorted to the Outdoor Basketball Court where they will meet with the activity instructor and taken to their class. When the activity finishes:

- All after-school activity (ASA) bus riders will congregate in the Melati Theater before being escorted to the buses, which will depart at 3:15 PM.
- Walkers will be dropped at the office to meet their parents.
- Car riders will be taken to the car pickup area for parent pickup.
- Any parent who chooses to pick up their child instead of riding the ASA bus on a particular day must meet the child in the Melati Theater and inform the ASA bus monitor and Transportation Office.

PIE ACTIVITIES STARTING FROM 3:00 PM OR LATER

 Children must either be in a 2:10 PM activity or supervised by parents or caretakers at all times if they have to wait for their next activity.



- If the activity starts right away at 3:00 PM, KG – Grade 2 students who are in a 2:10 PM activity will be escorted to the covered area to meet their 3:00 PM activity instructor.
- If the activity starts right away at 3:00 PM, Grades 3 – 5 students who are in a 2:10 PM activity walk alone to their 3:00 PM activity.
- If the activity starts later than 3:00 PM, children of all grades must be escorted by parents or caretakers to the activity.
- Children must be picked up by parents or caretakers from the activity location at end of the activity.
- There is no bus service for activities that end later than 3:00 PM.



PEL Dismissal, Pickup, and Supervision Procedures



PEL KG – Grade 5 ACTIVITIES STARTING AT 2:10 PM

At 2:00 PM, children will be escorted to the green-covered area where they will meet with the activity instructor and taken to their class.

When the activity finishes:

- All ASA bus riders will be taken to the green-covered area to meet their bus monitors, and then be taken to Gate B.
- Car riders from Grades 4 & 5 (with younger siblings) will be taken to Gate B for parent pickup.
- Car riders from Grades KG Grade 3 will be taken to Gate A for parent pickup.
- Any parent who chooses to pick up their child instead of riding the ASA bus on a particular day must meet at Gate B and inform the ASA bus monitor and Transportation Office.

PEL ACTIVITIES STARTING AT 3:00 PM OR LATER

 Children must either be in a 2:10 PM activity or supervised by a parent or caretaker at all times if they have to wait for their next activity.

- If the activity starts right away at 3:00 PM, KG – Grade 2 students who are in a 2:10 PM activity will be escorted to the green-covered area to meet their 3:00 PM activity instructor.
- If the activity starts right away at 3:00 PM, Grades 3 – 5 students who are in a 2:10 PM activity walk alone to their 3:00 PM activity.
- If the activity starts later than 3:00 PM, children of all grades must be escorted by a parent or caretaker to the activity.
- Children must be picked up by parents or caretakers from the activity location at end of the activity.
- There is no bus service for activities that end later than 3:00 PM.





Middle School and High School Procedures

After activities, Middle School and High School students should leave campus by a mode of transportation that has been previously arranged with the student and parents.




